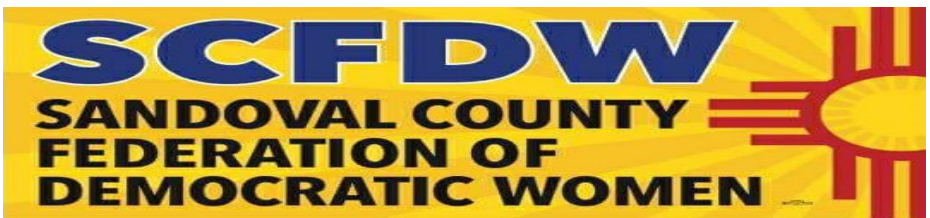
## December 2018 Meeting
